- 5 You must pay postage to send your entry. Crosslinks regrets it is unable to acknowledge or return entries. This competition is open to those within and outside the UK.
- 6 The judges' decision is final. Prizes will be posted to the address given.
- 7 The winners' names will be featured on the website and given to those who request it from the London office.
- 8 Parents and entrant agree that your Sheep picture may be used for Crosslinks' promotions, including the Crosslinks website, as an e-card illustration and displayed in the Crosslinks offices.
- 9 One entry per child, but others can put their entry in the same envelope.
