Brief Job Description:

1. Teaching at village seminars on disability issues; training village rehabilitation workers.
2. Meeting with clients in villages, counselling, history taking; working with parents etc. Advising on suitable local equipment.
3. Liaising with local authorities, and other NGO's, local hospital etc.
4. Assisting in administrative work and communicating with donors.
5. Training a national counterpart.
6. Assisting in the local church regularly.

A Special Educationist who is interested in community work could find this post very interesting and fulfilling as could an Administrator who could also use some of their time in Evangleism training/ Bible teaching to Church staff. The programme is fairly wide ranging

TANZANIA. Based in the town of Karagwe, in the Anglican Diocese of Kagera – Deanery of Kayanga.

Length of Term:

Three Years, but open to renewal of contract.

Qualifications/Skills:

Any of the qualifications listed for Physiotherapist; Occupational Therapist; Social Worker; Nurse. Experience preferable. Flexibility and determination required in a challenging location. Willingness to assist in the church which is young and weak would be essential.

Language:

Willingness to learn Swahili if not already acquired is essential.
