What's the need?

Mozambique faces a crucial time in her history. Following many years of war the Church has an important role to play consolidating and cultivating peace and the development of Mozambican nationals in every area of life.

Why Richard and Bianca?

Richard and Bianca trained in cross-cultural mission at All Nations Christian College where Richard earned a degree in biblical and inter-cultural studies. They have worked in Mozambique for two years and speak the national language – Portuguese

Bianca has run discipleship programmes with Portuguese speakers outside the UK and has run a pilot discipleship and development programme in Mozambique's capital, Maputo.

Richard has worked on promoting the importance of an arms amnesty project.

Richard and Bianca returned to Mozambique in Spring 2005 to use their gifts and experience serving a local congregation of the Mozambican

Reformed Church and help them to build on three areas – outreach, discipleship and economic independence. In each case they encourage and build upon initiatives that have come from the fellowship itself rather than imposing foreign ideas. They have been involved in:

- Vocational training to help people start their own businesses.
- Prayer and outreach Bible meetings amongst those on the fringes of the city who find it difficult to get to the city church. A city church member will invite individuals to come to a Bible study held on the outskirts. The study encourages participants to understand the word and to be committed to applying it to their every day life.
- Training and encouraging Mozambicans to take on positions of responsibility, including training the Mozambicans to take over from the Reeves.
